The next meeting of the 2021 Session will take place at 6pm on Wednesday, 10th February 2021 when Professor Graham Cooke MD FCR DPhil will speak on

COVID 19 – TOO LITTLE TOO LATE

Graham Cooke is NIHR Research Professor of Infectious Diseases based at Imperial College. Prior to 2020, his work focused on the management of hepatitis C, running strategic trials in the UK and Vietnam. He is at the forefront of international efforts to accelerate the elimination of viral hepatitis, and in 2019 led the influential Lancet Commission. Since 2017 he has chaired the WHO Essential Medicines Committee leading initiatives on antimicrobial stewardship and access to cancer medicines. In response to the challenge of COVID-19 he has been a PI on a number of clinical trials and led studies of new diagnostics, including the development of COVID nudge testing and the major home testing programme REACT.

The talk will give an overview of our current understanding of treatment for COVID-19 and the lessons we can learn for the future.
